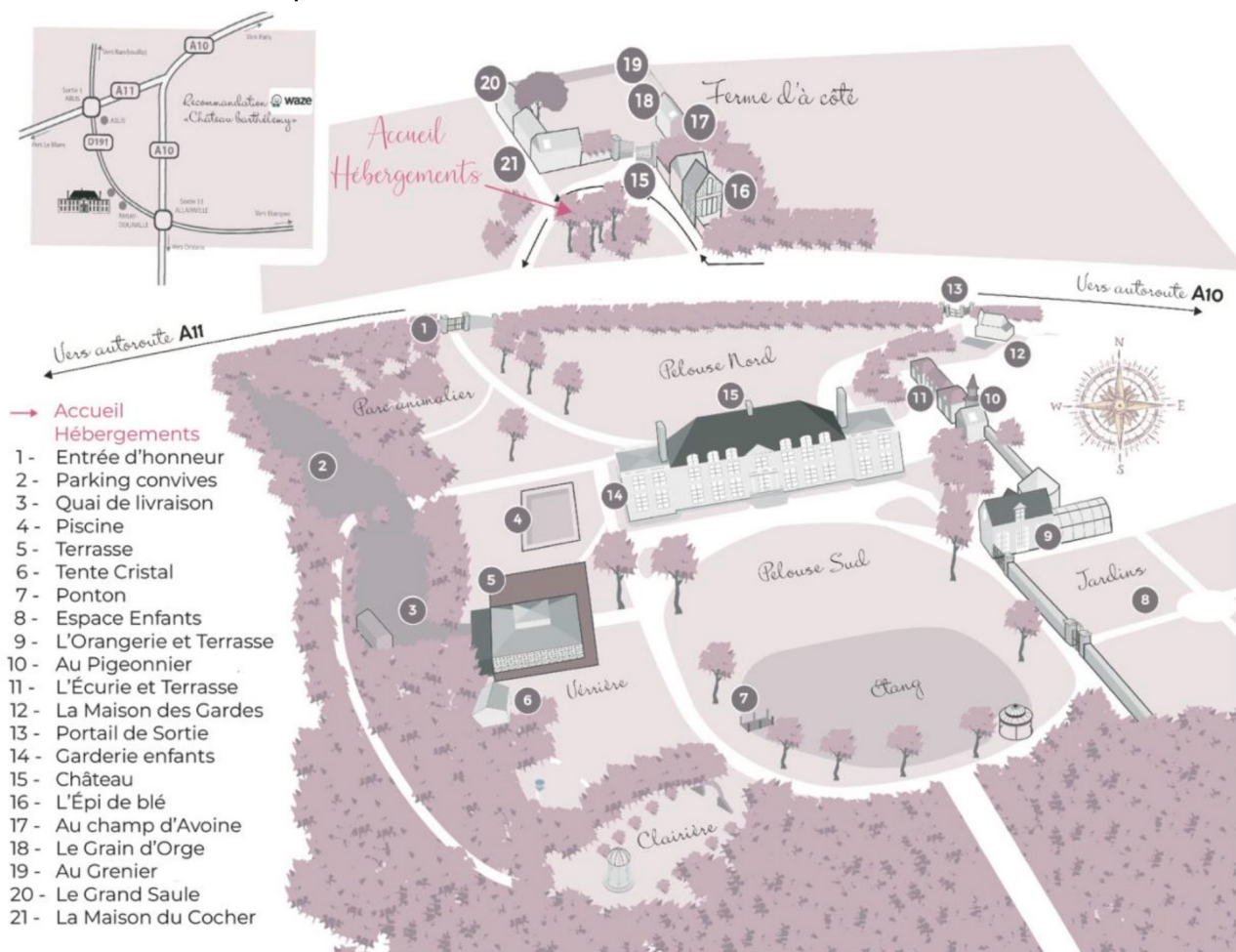
Welcome to your accommodation

The entire team is pleased to welcome you to Château Barthélemy.

To make your arrival on the big day easier, below you will find important information to ensure your stay runs smoothly.

■ Orientation:

The bride and groom have assigned you a specific accommodation, which you can locate on the map below.



Accommodations are distributed as follows:

Parc Cottages	Farm Cottages (next door)

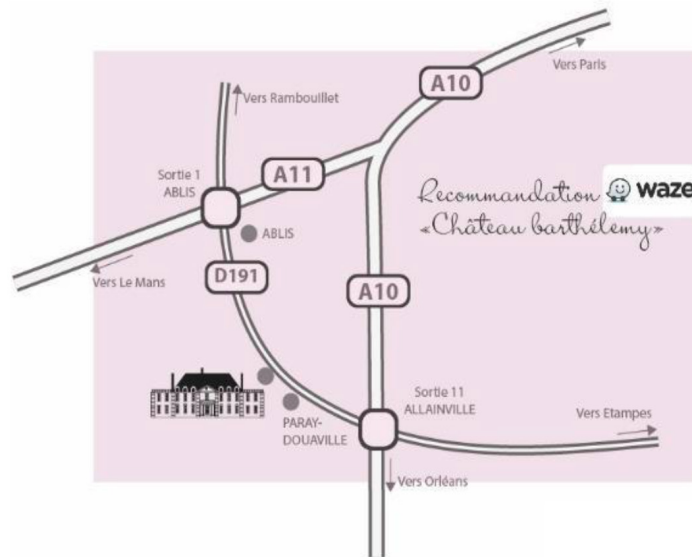
■ Access to Château Barthélemy:

To reach Château Barthélemy, we recommend using the WAZE app.

As you approach the estate, please reduce your speed to 50 km/h.

From the A10, access the château via the hamlet on the right.

From the A11/N10, access the château directly on the right.



■ Arrival at Château Barthélemy:

Residents of the Château and Parc Cottages: Upon entering the estate, follow the signs marked "Hébergement" (Accommodation). Reception and luggage drop-off are in front of the château. Parking is required in a nose-in (angled) configuration.

Residents of the Farm Cottages: Please go directly to Hameau de Douaville without stopping by the château.

You will be welcomed on-site. GPS coordinates: 48.470945, 1.866289

■ Room Check-in Times:

Check-in begins at 5:00 PM.

Reception staff will guide you to your cottage. Please note: there is no porter service.

■ Accommodation Guidelines:

The bed arrangements made by the bride and groom must be respected.

■ Parking:

Parc residents must park in the designated lot after dropping off luggage at the château. Only guests of the Guards' House may use the private parking adjacent to that cottage. Farm Cottage residents have access to a shared courtyard parking but may also park at the château for closer access to the event.

■ Keys:

Farm Cottage residents will be given a key set per room, including a front door key and a room key.

Keys must be returned to the board provided at the entrance of the cottage or left in the room door upon departure.

■ Comfort in Our Accommodations:

Each cottage includes shared common areas, depending on the layout chosen by the couple:

Equipped kitchen

Living/Dining room

Shared bathrooms and toilets

Amenities available:

Coffee machine + pods (coffee, chocolate)

Kettle + tea bags

Bottled water in the rooms

Towels in each bathroom

Shower products

Hairdryer in each bathroom

Iron + ironing board (use only in common areas)

Beds are fully prepared by housekeeping prior to arrival.

Note:

All accommodations are non-smoking.

Alcohol consumption inside the cottages is not allowed. Outdoor terrace areas are available.

Food is not permitted in bedrooms. Please use the kitchen for this purpose.

There is no WiFi, TV, telephone, or safe in the accommodations.

■ Extra Beds:

Inflatable mattresses are not allowed.

A designated tent area is available—please contact us for more details.

Baby cribs are allowed.

■ Reduced Mobility:

Rooms and bathrooms are not fully accessible for people with reduced mobility. However, many cottages have ground-floor rooms and bathrooms.

■ Pets:

Pets are not allowed inside the château and must be leashed within the estate.

Two uncovered kennels are available if needed.

■ Assistance:

For any assistance, please contact the manager, available 24/7.

The manager's number is displayed in the park, at your cottage entrance, and in your room. They can help with transfers to the Farm Cottages and guide you to your accommodation.

■ Room Check-out:

Rooms must be vacated by 11:00 AM the next day.

All personal items and luggage must be removed. You may load your vehicle or store your items in the glass-roofed cloakroom if brunch is planned.

■ Lost & Found:

After your departure, any items found during cleaning will be placed in the glass-roofed area (if brunch is held), or stored otherwise.

Please contact us promptly to retrieve your belongings.
